What is WYD:

World Youth Day is a great meeting of young people from all over the world gathered around the Vicar of Christ. WYD is an evangelical endeavor in which the Church manifests its constant concern for youth: "All young people should feel cared for by the Church: to do so, the whole Church, in union with the Successor of Peter, must feel increasingly committed at the global level, in favour of youth (...) to correspond to their expectations, communicating to them the certainty of Christ, the truth that is Christ, and the love that is Christ through adequate formation, which is a necessary and updated form of evangelization" (John Paul II, Address to the College of Cardinals, December 20, 1985).

And what is it about? let us tell you...

CATECHESIS SESSIONS

WYD participants, organized by linguistic groups, will have catechesis session with bishops from all over the World. The sessions will take place in churches, schools, auditoriums and sports centers of Madrid

The International urban Scout Camp of WYD will also host catechesis sessions. These will be delivered by scout bishops, with a close speech and a very scout style, because they will take place in a natural environment and they will have a familiar symbolic framework and preparation.

The 'YOUTH FESTIVAL' concept

Aside from the WYD main events, many different activities will take place throughout the day as a part of the Cultural Program. The program will include concerts, exhibits, guided museum visits, plays, and much, much more. The complete list of activities will be announced later, when all proposals have been received and processed.

MAIN EVENTS

There are some special events that will occur during WYD. These are:

WYD Opening Mass: The World Day begins at 7 pm (provisional time) with a Mass in Madrid's Cibeles Square, presided over by the archbishop of Madrid and concelebrated by the

bishops and priests participating in WYD.

Stations of the Cross (Via Crucis): It will take place on Friday evening. At each station, a float from the traditional Spanish Holy Week will be located, representing the scene. These statues will come from all over Spain.

Vigil with the Pope : On Saturday afternoon, the young pilgrims will go arriving little by little to Cuatro Vientos aerodrome. In the meanwhile, in the stage there will be several activities (youth testimonies, concerts, prayers to

the Virgin, etc) to get prepared for the prayer and Eucharistic adoration Vigil with the Pope starting at the sunset. That night everybody will sleep in the same spot.

WYD Mass of Sending: The Pope will concelebrate Mass with thousands of bishops and priests, and he will address young people and those who are not so young, to send them out to the world to witness to their faith, as the Lord did with his Apostles. At the end of the conclusive Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next edition of World Youth Day will be held.

As or even more important than the official program it is the informal program that will happen among participants, facilitating the mutual discovery, the cultural exchange and fun, turning the event into an unique living educational experience that will leave unforgettable footprints in every single scout

that takes part in this big gathering. We encourage to all those coming to WYD, to get prepared bringing all the best of their culture, costumes and way of living the faith and scouting in their home countries, to share it and to be enriched each other. Moving with this spirit, we will achieve a truly and successful World Youth Day.
