Then look no further

The story so far:

In 1925 a group of interested adults arranged a pilgrimage for Catholic Scout Groups to Rome.

The same group decided that a body concerned with the religious and spiritual development of Catholic Scouts was very important. So with the approval of the Catholic Hierarchy they formed the CSAC (The Catholic Scout Advisory Council), and a Bishop was appointed as its Religious Advisor.

Based on Dioceses, Guilds were formed in order to offer support at a local level. Diocesan Chaplains were also appointed to guide the Guilds.

Over many years the CSAC organised many activities and supporting Leaders to the benefit of the Scout Associations young people.

However there are no longer any Catholic Scout Guilds left with Avon & Bristol closing in 2016. Also many Catholic Sponsored Groups have diminished. Now many of our young Catholic people and Leaders belong to other faith or non-denominational Groups. Many Catholic adults also work at National, Regional, County and District levels in many differing roles.

In 2005 and in line with the Scout Association policy of all Scout adult support groups coming under its adult support section and the CSAC became The National Catholic Scout Fellowship (NCSF).

2011 saw another name change from Fellowship to Scout Active Support Units but the NCSF was able to retain its title with the addition "Actively Supporting Catholics In Scouting".

Membership is open to all Catholics involved in Scouting in any capacity. You can join as an individual (£10) or as a Group (£25). Any difficulty paying subs? Then contact the Treasurer.

Membership is due annually in October, which coincides with the NCSF's Annual Review.

Membership includes a vote at the Annual general Meeting usually held in October. A copy of the LINK our newsletter is published at least three times a year and more if necessary. More importantly your subscription enables the NCSF to support and be the voice of Catholic Scouting in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

The NCSF also has an appointed National Chaplain by the Bishops Conference of England and Wales and we continue to have an appointed Bishop as our Religious advisor.

The NCSF is also a paid up member of the International Catholic Conference of Scouting (ICCS) and we send a delegate to its AGM.
